

## Wooden Gallop

### Medium

Mixed media (paint, paper, fragments of wood, and rusted metals) on plywood

### Description

This is a mixed media on plywood artwork. It is a type of work that blurs the line between painting and sculpture: invented by the artist, he termed the artwork "Combine."



This "Combine" includes brushwork, paper, fragments of wood, and various (rusted) metals attached to a plywood panel. A deflated yellow rubber life raft with a wooden paddle protrudes upward and outward from the frame. A coke can dangles from the yellow raft.
