Description

This is an oil on canvas painting done in memory of Susan Watkins a year after she died. She was also a painter and the room she sits in suggests that this was her studio. Behind her and in the center of the canvas is a jar of paint brushes. The brushwork for this portrait is loose and soft. She is the central focus, formally dressed in a long white gown with

a white coat over her shoulders. Her dark brown hair has been done up on her head and pulled away from her face.
