## Description

This teapot, which is part of a three piece tea service, is elliptical in form with an applied tapered spouut and applied wood handle which fits into applied sockets. The top is engraved with meandering leafage with bands of engraving at both the lip and bottom as well as a band of beading. The top is surmounted with an elliptical wood handle. Teapot body is engraved with an empty oval cartouche topped with a bow and trailing band of swagged vines of roses and leaves around the body and joining another oval cartouche engraved with a central crest as yet unidentified.
