



Decanter | Stopper

Description

Blown and cut colorless flint. Neck: double ring, fluted between rings. Shoulder: 11 broad flutes above a diamond band. Bottom half: "pencil" flutes over 17 broad flutes. Ground and polished pontil. Stopper is pressed non-lead of a later date.
