## Description

Sugar bowl of opaque white pressed glass. Nine sides flaring to rim. Round foot. Each side has a sunken arched panel with a raised depiction of a different pressed glass article. From left to right these are: a sugar bowl, bar bottle, goblet & ale glass in the Excelsior pattern; a hexagonal candlestick; a spillholder (?) in Excelsior pattern; a bar bottle in Ashburton pattern; a goblet in flute pattern; and a spillholder (?) with an eight-pointed star on the side. Fair condition. Flakes on rim. The two most severe being at the corner between the flute goblet & star spillholder & above the Excelsior sugar bowl. Large flake in foot under Excelsior ale glass. Lid is missing.
