### Description

This is an oil on board painting. It is a small study of the Brooklyn Bridge from the vantage point of the ground, looking to the Bridge on the right. The top half of the painting shows diagonal lines, intersecting to form the steel cables. Dots of yellow and white signify lights. The lines, layered over each other and in every direction, illustrate the movement and energy of the Bridge.
