Description

Sherry glass of blown colorless glass. Conical bowl and hollow knob stem. Acid-etched with a crowned "GR VI" cypher over the date 1937, and the symbols of Great Britain—the rose, thistle, and shamrock. Hollow knob in stem contains 1937 coronation medal with London hallmarks date letter "A" and "T&S".
