Description

This is an acrylic on canvas painting; the canvas is straight at the bottom edge but the top is formed in semicircles; inside the four outlined sections are three interlocking rainbows of different colors. From the left, a quarter of a circle (upper left quarter) is outlined in blue, with half a rainbow inside the outline. The next section is an interlocking rainbow of colors, outlined in a darker blue and is followed by a similar section outlined in green. The two middle sections have three rounded peaks on the top edge of the canvas; the middle sections share one full rainbow, and contain half of the rainbow design that connects to the end sections, which flank the middle rainbow. The last section is outlined in black and again, is shaped as upper right quarter of a circle.
