## Description

This is an oil on canvas painting; it is a square canvas tilted so that the top, bottom and sides each is a point of the corners. Within the "diamond" canvas, Indiana drew a

yellow-bordered circle. Below the circle in stenciled letters are the words "Fire Bridge." Within the circle, he depicts a symetrically balanced bridge with two arches. This painting is in reference to the Brooklyn Bridge, New York; it features one of the bridge's gothic towers in black, and the cables in red and yellow, set against a dark blue sky.
