Description

Tall cylindrical vase flares slightly at foot, more so at mouth. Qingpai type glaze shows low relief design of a kylin in a rocky landscape. Design register terminates well above foot; incised flame motifs, pointing down, border it. Mouth rim brown, bottom slightly concave, unglazed discolored. Interior also Qingpai type glaze.
