Description

This is an oil on board study for the painting _The Angel Appearing to the Shepherds_ (80.30). It is one of three preparatory sketches for the large painting, and of the three this one is believed to be the oldest. On the left side of the canvas, a palm tree leans as an angel dressed in blue glides toward the shepherds, dressed in blue, red and a tan/gold cloaks. Sheep graze under the palm tree and the foreground may depict a river. A large star is on the right side of the canvas and distant buildings are barely visible.
