### Description

Torso is missing arms just below shoulders, head and legs at knees. Body well modeled, void of design except for garment which falls low on hips, has belt around lower abdomen and double pointed ornaments at front. Two circles with central bosses at back. Garment very snug, indicated by striations on legs. Legs cylindrical in form. Mounted on wooden base, metal brace.
