## Art Nouveau Vase

### Medium

Blown, acid-etched, enameled, and relief-gilt glass

### Description

Vase enameled over acid etched design. Cylindrical pinched in at the top with a short neck and a flaring rim. Attached narrow solid dome foot with star cut bottom. Decorated with thick gilt background with glossy design on the foot. Three "frames" on cylinder part and solid on the neck, rim and inside to neck bottom over acid-cut "cameo" stylized bluebell/morning glory art nouveau

design. Inside gilt "frames" are three panels enameling of blue flowers with yellow centers and green leaves on clear with irregularly etched background.
