### Description

This is an oil on canvas painting referring to the Old Testament story of Sarai, Abraham's wife, and Hagar, Sarai's Egyptian slave. Sarai is shown from the side, on a stone-like platform in a chair. She wears a veil and cloak of white fabric; her waist is bound to a chair with a rope; the rope trails off the platform. Her arms and hands are covered by long black gloves, and she holds a bouquet of red flowers in her lap. White tennis shoes peek out from

under her cloak. Behind her is an empty beach with clouds overhead.
