## Silver Serving Spoon with Cameo-carved Handles in White on Ruby Ground

### Date

ca. 1890-1900

### Primary Maker

### Medium

Blown, cased, etched, and cameo-carved glass with sterling silver

### Description

This is a serving set; it includes a spoon and fork with a violet and rose motif in an unusual application. Ruby glass handles cased with opaque white, shaped like elongated vases with rounded bulbous ends, long tapering "necks" and flaring "rims", cameo-carved with two white bands and floral motifs. The ovoid three tined fork and spoon and have long narrow cylindrical shafts that terminate in cylindrical shanks that abut the glass handles.
