## Fluted Column with "Temple of the Winds" Capital from the interior of the George Blow House, Norfolk

### Medium

Cast iron, wood, and paint by James L. Jackson Iron Works, New York City

### Description

The capitals are iron (each cast in one piece), and the shafts are wooden. The capitals are in the Greek-taste "Temple of the Winds" design - the abacus is square with a cavetto molding and anthemion on the underside of its corners; beneath it are vertical leaves (like those found in the cornices of Egyptian buildings) and below these acanthus leaves. The wooden columns are fluted and have a bead at the top and at the base.
