Description

This is a Worcester square dessert dish painted in the London workshop of James Giles in shades of rose, purple, iron-red yellow, and green. It has a central floral bouquet within a brown line entwined with a green foliate vine around the cavetto below the gilt dentil-edged serpentine rim. It has been repaired and the rim chips have been restored.
