### Description

This is a Worcester 'Pu Tai' Pattern Teabowl (A) and Saucer (B). Each piece painted in iron-red, blue, rose, yellow and black and heightened in gilding with the corpulent Pu Tai Ho-shang seated before an iron-red patterned pyramid and waving a whisk at his two attendants: a man with a brocade ball and Guanyin holding a tall lotus stem, and the interior rim with an iron-red-edged gilt spearhead border.
