### Description

These are cast iron components of a fence, or entourage,

from the Paris Métropolitain stations designed by Hector Guimard circa 1900. They are painted white, green and black to simulate patinated bronze, with a final coating of lacquer. Four cast iron escutcheons incorporate a stylized letter M for Métro. They are accompanied by four slightly arched handrails/bars and eight vertical cross bars.
