Description

The piece is a translucent royal blue goblet. Two connected tendrils of glass extend up from the foot to make the stem. The pieces of glass are attached to side of the bowl to form “c” curves with large gathers of glass on their ends. The bowl is thin and blown that tapers slightly in the body and widens at the rim.
