Description

A hollow, blown sphere with swirling, iridescent rainbow hues scattered across the matrix like a starburst. The bottom has been cold-worked with a flat circular spot for stability. This work was made starting out with a flat disc of dichroic glass that had been fused with several layers of opaque black glass; this disc was heated, free-blown, and shaped with the addition of overlaid gathers of clear glass to increase size and thickness of the sculpture.
