This sand was collected by David Compton, Coastal Zone Coordinator, on April 22, 2020. Mr. Compton shares the sand's significance: "Oceanfront is bordered by military bases, residential homes, and resort hotels. The Army Corps of Engineers and the City replenish the beach with

sand dredged from nearby channels. This helps maintain navigational access to the Chesapeake Bay, while keeping beaches wide for beachgoers and protecting the seawall and infrastructure from storm events." Atelier NL sand archive sample identification number: Virginia Beach-US-0036.
